TRAIN THE TRAINER CONFERENCE

Get HOPE Global (GHG) received with partnership and support from Concordia Lutheran Ministries and Hoffman Family Foundation (HFF) to provide 23 women's group leaders with a three day Train the Trainer conference in Jinja, Uganda in June 2022. Loretta Namagembe, HFF Administrator, shares the impact of this training:

The Hoffman Family Foundation empowers families of orphans and other vulnerable children to become self-reliant. This past year the leaders of the women's empowerment groups attended a business training conference with Get Hope Global. These leaders, ranging in age from 18-65 years, have further trained members of their local groups. A total of 394 women have benefitted.

During this interactive training the participants learned to express themselves with confidence and new public-speaking skills. This did not leave the leaders the same. Members learned to respect each other and to also respect each other's ideas.

Participants were able to relate their day to day running of the businesses to the training and the Bible stories as the basis of the curriculum. This was a reminder to all that prayer is the key. We must put God first in our endeavors and give thanks to Him as we strive to achieve our big hopes. This training spoke to all participants, both Christians and non-Christians, who loved learning more about the Bible and Christianity during the training.

This training encouraged all participants to think out of the box and be creative with a diversity of ideas as they worked to make business plans suitable for their communities. They were taught to be committed and persistent despite the problems that occur while running a business, like they learned from Anna's Story in the curriculum. They learned how to nurture their business with patience.

They learned that they are accountable to their businesses and to the members of their groups as leaders. The Bible stories challenged them to be honest.

In reference to all the above, the leaders have been able to use this training and the curriculum manual provided to them to transfer this knowledge to the women's groups they lead. In fact, the businesses of the women have already improved, hence boosting the savings of the group members at the closure of 2022. We hope the same knowledge will be put into practice in 2023.
